



RULES OF CONDUCT FOR THE YOUTH MEMBERS USING THE FAMILY CENTER

Youth members are at the heart of what we do at the Y. We hope that your membership will be a fun, meaningful experience for you. To make the Y a place that is enjoyable for everyone, we ask that all youth members abide by the following rules:

1. Youth members are RESPONSIBLE for bringing their cards every visit. Swipe the card at the front desk. Failure to bring card may result in delayed entry.
2. Entrance to the building for swimming will be allowed within 10 minutes of the session beginning.
3. The Lobby is not a place to gather or just “hang out”.
4. Youth members should show RESPECT by treating other members in a friendly, caring manner. Sharing space in the pool for all to enjoy.
5. Drinks and snacks MUST be eaten before entering the building.
6. Bring your own towel.
7. Coats, hats, book bags and other personal belongings are to be placed in a locker. The Y is not responsible for valuables and personal items that are stolen or left behind.
8. The locker room is only for changing clothes and going to the restroom. Clean up after yourself. Place trash in the trash receptacle.
9. Vulgar language and inappropriate behavior are not allowed and can lead to loss of privileges.
10. Proper bathing suits are required. Cut-offs are not allowed, but other normal “land-wear” is allowed, if permission is given by Aquatic Director.
11. Open Swim – Children ages 10 and older may swim without an adult.
12. Family Swim – Swimmers must be 16 to swim without a parent.
13. During Open Swim or Family Swim, members under 18 are not allowed to bring a guest without an accompanying parent.
14. Guests must reside outside a 30-mile radius from the Altavista Y facility.
